



Farncombe School Assessment Results 2019

Year 2 Reading, Writing and Maths Tests

These assessments take place in May of Year 2, just before pupils move to junior school. Pupils at Farncombe School consistently achieve well above national expectation in these end of KS1 tests (formerly known as SATS). 2019 national data will be added when published by the Department for Education in Autumn 2019.

Year 1 Phonics Screening Test

This is measured in June of Year 1 (the second year of school) and assesses a child's ability to decode a word using the sounds such as *th*, *oi*, *ar*, *igh* as well as individual letters. A child who reaches the pass threshold is likely to continue to read well.

Good Level of Development (GLD)

This is measured at the end of the first year of school (Reception) and indicates a child is on track to achieve well, both socially and academically. At Farncombe, several pupils reach one or two of these key goals in the first term of Year 1, missing GLD in Reception by a small margin. The school tracks these pupils carefully through Year 1 and 2 to ensure they 'catch up', as is indicated in the Year 2 data above.
